All Starz educates and entertains children in grades 1-3. *All Starz* explores critical issues of bullying in the lives of young children. Students witness verbal, non-verbal and physical behaviors that reflect episodes of real-life bullying. They observe positive role modeling when the characters work together to come to an awareness about respecting everyone.

Major Learning Points:

- ◆ What is the difference between teasing and bullying?
- ◆ Understanding the differences between reporting and tattling
- ◆ Learn when and how to seek help from adults
- ◆ Understanding the importance of respecting differences
- ◆ Reaching out to friends and classmates who are victims of bullying

About the Play:

All Starz follows three students through two days at school. Kim rules the playground and has set up a "Club", putting herself in charge of picking the members. Jackie wants to fit in with the popular kids and quickly falls under Kim's influence. Michael just wants the girls to leave him alone so he can play boys sports where there are "*no girls allowed*". Soon all three characters are caught up in social conflict which causes each of them to make mistakes. Through the help of the principal, they all realize that telling people what to do, name calling and exclusion are not the way to make friends.

Post Performance:

Following the performance an interactive after-show discussion features the three actors/educators who help reinforce the educational points of the play.
